

- Sanding your divots is key to maintaining great course conditions.
- Please repair pitch marks on the greens.
- Slow play should be a concern for all Members and guests. It should take no longer than 4 hours to complete a round. The staff understands that it may take longer if it is cart path only. Please be aware of your pace of play.
- Facility carts and private carts should be kept at least 30 yards away from all greens/fringes. They should never be on or near the tee boxes.






